

# A Word by Dan Brett

I graduated from Akron University in 1972 and moved to Naples to work with Dad in the Air Conditioning business. 175 was still under construction, so I traveled down Florida thru the center of the state. The final leg of my trip was late at night, coming thru Immokalee and down Immokalee Road into Naples. I had to stop on Immokalee Road for gas; thankfully, I had a gas can in my van. AT FIRST, when I stopped, it was dead quiet, but after a few minutes, the sounds around me came back to life—frogs, crickets, and another deep grunting

I finally made it into Naples and flagged down a Naples City Policeman. I asked him which direction was Naples Parks, specifically 101st Ave No. He said it was about 5 miles back north somewhere. So, I headed north and located my parents and siblings. When I arrived,

Dad was busy building custom cabinets, running Brett Air Conditioning, and assisting my brother with his construction business.

Brett Air Conditioning grew, and I came on full-time. Mom answered the phones, and dad ran the business out of our garage in the back. I remember carrying a roll of dimes with me and using payphones to check in with mom between service calls. I learned my way around Naples by carrying a city map with me.

To give you a visual of how small Naples was, I would leave 101st Ave in Naples Park and head south on Tamiami Trail. I could reach Naples High School (then on 22nd Ave N) before hitting any traffic signals. If you travel that same distance on Tamiami Trail today, you will find 15 stoplights.

Over the years, J.P. Brett & Sons grew, and we moved the business from the garage to a storefront on Tamiami Trail just south of Pine Ridge Road. We shared the plaza with Naples Metalcraft and D.C. Aluminum.

In 1987 we purchased a warehouse building with offices. It was perfect for our growing business. Today, we still operate J.P.

Brett and Sons out of the same building.

I was most fortunate to meet some wonderful people that became long-term customers and friends. You can read some of their comments in this newsletter.

Many of those friends are still with us to this day. Naples has become my home, my family's home, and the home of my grandchildren. I am blessed today to see another generation stepping up to run Brett Air Conditioning.
