FALL RECIPE

Ingredients:

1 – Pillsbury Deep dish pie crust

Filling:

8 cups sliced, cored, peeled granny smith apples

½ cup granulated sugar

¼ cup All-purpose flour

¼ teaspoon ground cinnamon

1 Tablespoon Lemon juice

Topping:

½ cup unsalted butter, softened

1 cup all-purpose flour

2/3 cup packed brown sugar

1 Tablespoon granulated sugar



Dutch Apple Pie

Directions:

Heat oven to 400°F. In large bowl, gently mix filling ingredients.

Once all apples are coated, Pour into pie crust, with the mound of apples towards center. In medium saucepan melt butter and brown sugar together. Then slowly add flour and combine the topping ingredients until a crumb forms. Sprinkle evenly over top of pie. Sprinkle 1 tablespoon granulated sugar on top.

Bake 45 to 55 minutes or until pie crust and crumb topping are deep golden brown and filling begins to bubble. If crust gets to dark, you can lay a loose piece of aluminum foil over the top to allow it from burning. Transfer to cooling rack to cool.
