A2L Freon, the next-generation, low-GWP refrigerant:

Many have heard the news about the new A2L refrigerant and we would like to answer some of your questions.

As of January 1, 2024, production was reduced by 40% for all refrigerants, including R-410A. As a result, a new type of refrigerant must be used. A2L refrigerants with a low Global Warming Potential (GWP) and A2L compatible equipment will begin replacing the 410A units we are used to.

Our JP Brett & Sons technicians have undergone numerous training courses to stay updated with the changes in this new refrigerant. We have equipped each of them with proper A2L-compatible equipment, parts, and tools to ensure adequate safety precautions when installing, maintaining, and servicing equipment with this new refrigerant.

Can A2L refrigerants be used to retrofit R-410a or R-22 units? No. They should only be used in systems specifically designed for this type of refrigerant. In a nutshell, the old refrigerant is not compatible. If your outdoor or indoor unit goes out, replacing the entire system with an A2L system will be required.

Are A2L Refrigerants Safe to Use? Safety is a primary concern when handling refrigerants. A2L refrigerants are considered safe when handled correctly. They have been rigorously tested and approved by regulatory bodies for use in HVAC systems.
